State Bar of Michigan (8/08)



The State Bar of Michigan facility was built in 1959; a multi-story addition was added in 1979. It is a masonry structure on the downtown area steam distribution system provided by the municipal utility. The Technical Energy Audit identified wall areas not yet insulated and problems with the water heating system. Large savings were anticipated from retro-commissioning of the ventilation and DHW systems.
